COMPLAINT AGAINST AN OFFICER

The Telford Borough Police Department is committed to serving the community in a professional manner. If you believe that you have witnessed, or have experienced, misconduct by any member of the Telford Borough Police Department you have a right to file a complaint. All complaints will be thoroughly investigated and the outcome revealed to you in writing upon the completion of the investigation. In the event that you are not satisfied with the outcome, you are encouraged to contact the Telford Borough Mayor at (215) 723-5000.

In an effort to assure fairness and accuracy, any complaint against an officer must be filed within a reasonable time (30 days) of an incident. It is strongly suggested that you put the complaint in writing for clarity and accuracy purposes. This form is provided to assist you in making the complaint. The Chief of Police or his designate will investigate the complaint. In the event that your complaint involves the Chief of Police, you should contact the Mayor directly.

The officer who is the subject of the complaint will receive a copy of the complaint form. In the event a disciplinary action is taken, the accused officer has the right to request a hearing before the Telford Borough Civil Service Commission and/or an appropriate disciplinary committee. By filing a complaint, you are agreeing to testify, if called upon, in any scheduled disciplinary hearing.
